- Sacramento City Climate Action and Adaptation Plan, draft expected in March

**Transportation**

- Sacramento City Transportation Priorities Plan workshop at City Council 2 PM, Jan. 25
- Sacramento County Sales Tax measure, “Citizens group” language expected this month, for November ballot (Measure A redux?) and Southeast Connector
- Caltrans plans to widen I-80 causeway between Davis and West Sacramento; and CapCity (Business 80) Freeway between midtown and Arden
- Green Line to Airport – possible EIR this year

- Development plans in Sacramento County: Upper West Side, Grand Park, Jackson Township, Airport South, CNU Hospital in North Natomas, ...
